A Lyons' Wish

“Imagine being on top of the world and - in a period of seven days - you are forced to see the frailty, the unfairness and the wonder of life. I decided to use my name and my God-given talent to make a difference in the lives of terminally-ill children.” - Marty Lyons

Within one week in March 1982, Marty Lyons, a defensive lineman for the New York Jets for 12 years, was faced with three life-altering challenges: as a father—the birth of his first son, as a son—the death of his father; and as a Big Brother—the loss of Keith to leukemia.

True to his words, and with the encouragement and support of family and friends, in December of 1982 Marty established a foundation dedicated to granting wishes to children with a life-threatening or terminal illness. The philosophy behind his mission was that by promoting hope and inspiration in a sick child, they will find the courage and strength to fight their illness. What was perceived as impossible could become possible!

For the past 40 years, The Marty Lyons Foundation has granted over 8,000 wishes to their wish children (ages 3 to 17) through their original First Wish Program, and will consider a second wish to a deserving child through their unique Second Wish Program. They are proud to have 10 chapters covering 13 states.
