Tick Awareness & Management Workshop for Schools

Topics to Be Covered:

- Hour 1 Classroom Presentation by NYSIPM Specialist on tick species, ecology, disease potential & management strategies.
- Hour 2 Participants build tick drag mats for monitoring tick activity outdoors.
- Hour 3 Exterior grounds Participants will learn how to perform a tick drag and how to identify ticks and how to interpret the results. Various management strategies will be discussed.

The NY State IPM Program has a long history of cooperation with K-12 schools to promote the adoption of integrated pest management & best practices for indoor & outdoor pests. Ticks are of increasing concern for New Yorkers & disease incidence is on the rise. To keep school children safe while attending school, grounds departments need to understand & effectively manage ticks & exposure to ticks. This workshop is offered by Extension Specialists of the NYSIPM Program for free, and participants will walk away with knowledge, resources & a tick sampling tool to be used in their own district.
